



Point In Time Count

2009 - 2012 -17.2%

- Point-in-Time (PIT) estimates offer a snapshot of homelessness of both sheltered and unsheltered homeless populations—on a single night.
- **62,6**19 veterans were homeless on a single night in 2012. Homelessness among veterans has declined by 17.2 percent since 2009.


